- ❑ **The Light in the Piazza book by Craig Lucas; music & lyrics by Adam Guettel:** This delightful and touching Tony Award-winning musical, tells the story of a wealthy Southern woman and her beautiful but developmentally slowed daughter who spend an enlightening summer in Italy together.
- ❑ **Paradise Lost by Clifford Odets:** One of Odets' greatest plays. It traces a Jewish American family through the Great Depression. "Odets' most brilliant writing, it gushes with joy and aches with melancholy." *Harold Clurman*
- ❑ **Brooklyn Boy by Donald Margulies:** One of Margulies' funniest and most moving plays. It traces a suddenly celebrated writer's unwitting struggle to connect with his past.
- ❑ **Cigarettes and Chocolate & Hang Up by Anthony Minghella:** This brilliant writer (*The English Patient; Truly, Madly, Deeply*) examines our need for love and our sense of isolation in these 2 romantic, witty, intelligent and tender pieces.
- ❑ **The Enchanted by Jean Giraudoux:** A masterfully comic and romantic examination of heavenly and earthly love - with an original musical score.
- ❑ **Liebele by Arthur Schnitzler:** A touching, surprising and gripping indictment of sexuality, love and society by the brilliant Viennese playwright.
- ❑ **The Blue Angel by Pam Gems:** A new stage adaptation of the 1930s Marlene Dietrich film. A respected professor falls in love with a beautiful cabaret singer and havoc results.
- ❑ **A Loss of Roses by William Inge:** Inge's rarely produced play that tells a delicate story about a woman who finds love in unlikely places.
